Durability and aesthetics were the selling points of Fabral's roofing panels for the First Baptist Church. The architect insisted on a low-maintenance, long-term product and was able to get both while saving money for the congregation because the lightweight aluminum did not require special considerations in construction of the foundation or framing. The roof panels are divided into 32 sections and flashed into 12x12-inch curbs. Between each curb are 16 panels, all roll formed and bevel-cut on site to accommodate the design. Panels were lifted to the roof by crane.
